

## EPA's Electronics Environmental benefits Calculator (EEBC)

### **Purpose**

The EEBC estimates the environmental benefits of improving the management of electronic products, focusing on areas such as computer desktops, monitors, notebooks/laptops, mobile phone reuse and recycling, and recycling mixed loads of electronic equipment.

#### **Estimation of Benefits**

The calculator computes the benefits of purchasing and using products covered by the EPEAT ecolabel, using a lifecycle approach to estimate the advantages over non-EPEAT products.

### **Impact Analysis**

The EEBC captures the environmental impacts associated with raw material extraction, manufacturing, and energy

## PRI signatory growth in 2006-2023










