Feature within Entra (Formerly Azure AD) Enterprise Applications

Automates the process of user accounts:

- Creating creates user accounts when added.
- Managing synchronizes updates and changes.
- Deactivating deactivates user when no longer needed.

Streamlines lifecycle management:

- Reduces manual allocation, increasing efficiency.
- Removes license automatically.

Enhances Security:

- Reduces access risks.
- Tracks and audits changes.



The Mechanics Behind Automated Provisioning

Automated Provisioning is the integration between your organisations Entra Portal
and the Publisher Portal.



- The integration is commonly set up using the **SCIM 2.0 Standard**.
- Entra Enterprise Application Gallery provides pre-intergrated provisioning connectors
- Entra can also support automated provisioning for SaaS platforms that support SCIM 2.0 user management (not covered in this session).



Steps to Verify and Set Up Automated Provisioning in Entra

- 1. **Verify** automated provisioning is available
- 2. Set up your **Users and Groups** for access to the platform
- 3. Configure Automated Provisioning


The following steps can only be preformed by Global Admin, Cloud Application Administrator or Application Administrator roles in Entra;


- Add the Application from the Entra Gallery.
- Add the Admin credentials of the SaaS platform to Entra.
- Configure Attribute Mapping: to sync relevant data.
- Add the Users or Groups: choose which users or groups you want to sync.
- Turn on Automated Provisioning: this will enable the provisioning and start syncing the groups and users.
- 4. After syncing, **log into the portal and assign the license** to the group.



Exploring Publishers with Automated Provisioning

Applications > Enterprise Applications > New Application








- Each SaaS platform has different requirements
- 2. Validate attribute mapping
- 3. Consider Any Implications
 - Example: If the Publishers portal required email instead of UPN, you may need to register

additional domains in the SaaS platform.








Automated Provisioning can provision Users or Groups, but Groups have a number of advantages:

- **Greater Control:** The Owner of an Entra group can change the user in the group, this gives greater control, without additional access.
- **Integration:** Groups can be configured with request management systems.
- **Enhanced Audit capabilities:** Track who and when users are being added and removed from groups.
- Additional Automation and Reporting capabilities.



Preparing for Successful Automated Provisioning Implementation Entra Groups

- Transparent Group Naming: the name given in Entra will be synced to the portal.
- License Assignment to Groups: every user added to the group will get the license.
- **Group for Admins/unlicensed users:** users who need access to the portal, but not a licence.





Automation

- Daily Compliance Check: Set up automated workflows to check and ensure compliance on a daily basis.
- **Notification of License Assignment:** Automatically send notifications when licenses are assigned or updated.
- **Check for Conflicting Licenses:** Automatically check if a user has any conflicting or duplicate licenses.
- Provisioned/On-Demand License Tracking: Enable license to be assigned on a time limited basis (where allowed).





Reporting


- **Trending Analysis:** Provide insight on the license consumption vs entitlement.
- **Usage Analysis:** Connect with install and/or usage dataset to identify usage patterns and reclamation opportunities.
- User Transparency: Offer visibility into license usage across the organization, segmented by department, user type, and other relevant criteria.
- **Budget & Forecasting:** Leverage Trending Analysis to predict future license needs and budget requirements.





- Automated Provisioning: Automates the creation, management, and deletion of user accounts in Publisher Portals, streamlining user lifecycle management.
- **Entra Gallery:** Publishers with Automated Provisioning capabilities are available in the Entra Gallery for easy integration.
- **Group Management:** Enabling groups allows you to centrally manage user licenses directly from Entra.
- **Automated Notifications:** Once enabled, you can set up automated notifications for compliance and any changes to user accounts.
- **Tracking & Reporting:** Use data to track compliance and provide comprehensive reports on usage and license requirements to support better decision-making in your organization.







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
