

Roles and Options

- Using staff to collect and consolidate
- Centralize inventories when possible
- Provide sufficient workspace and power for white glove services
- Ensure proper packing for maintaining values in transport
- Obtain proper documentation (COI, asset reports, BOL)
- Determine schedules for day-to-day and event-based collection
- Direct transport vs LTL (vet the downstream)






